Re: Budget Reduction

Governor Pete Ricketts has recommended budget reductions for FY2016/2017 to state agencies which is being reviewed by the Legislature. State appropriated grant programs at the Nebraska Crime Commission may be affected by any subsequent action taken by the Legislature.

In anticipation of action, effective immediately: All funds that have not been disbursed by the Nebraska Crime Commission to 2013, 2014, and 2015 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Subgrantees are hereby retained by the Nebraska Crime Commission. All subgrantees with carryover funds from 2013, 2014, and 2015 will be notified individually by Cynthia Kennedy or Danni McGown regarding amounts that will be deobligated. Additionally, there may be reductions for the 2016 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Program.

This is a challenging time in the economy for government agencies. It is a reminder that timely submission of reports are vital when managing state grant funds that can dissipate when state general funds experience budget reductions. Moving forward, project period extensions will not be granted, until notified otherwise by the Nebraska Crime Commission. Please hold all questions until you have been individually notified by Cynthia Kennedy or Danni McGown.
