Purpose of the program: To assist those youths that are seeking education and career training to obtain and maintain self-sufficiency. We do this by offering personalized services that address educational and employment goals that will lead to self-sufficiency.

Steps to enrolling into the program:

Step 1: Attend orientation on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, offered every week.

Step 2: Take the career and basics skills assessments

- CareerScope (interest/aptitude test)
- TABE (basic skills assessment)

Step 3: **Gather necessary documents listed below**

Necessary documents for an intake appointment:

- “ Picture ID/Driver’s License
- “ Proof of Address
- “ Social Security Card
- “ Proof of All Household Income *see below for guidelines
- “ Proof of Family Size
- “ Proof of Public Assistance (SNAP/TANF)

If you need assistance in obtaining any of these documents, please contact Tonya at (402)-934-2664 and she will direct you to resources within the State.

Step 4: A Talent Development Specialist will be assigned to you and will contact you to schedule an appointment to start the application process.
