



CAROLE'S HOUSE OF HOPE INFORMATION SHEET

Carole's House of Hope (CHH) serves pregnant and parenting women who are:

- Between the ages of 19-26
- Parenting children 10 years or younger (No more than 2 children)
- Aged out of foster care
- Transitioned from other programs
- Chronically Homeless

We understand there will be individuals that do not fall within these guidelines. Therefore, we consider each applicant on an individual basis.

CHH offers:

- A caring and engaging staff
- Savings Incentive Program to assist with transition to independent living
- Courses that develop skills necessary to successfully transition to independent living
- Onsite WIC services
- Individual rooms (some with private baths)
- Spacious kitchen and common lounging area
- Safe home-like environment and beautiful outdoor surroundings
- Scholarship fund
- Activities and Outings

Fees include:

- A \$50 non-refundable deposit (*Utilized for baby monitor, linens, toiletries and additional items that become the personal property of the participant*)
- Program fees of \$300 monthly (*Covers onsite 24-hour staff, access to food pantry if needed, case management, referrals for community resources, limited transportation, clothing boutique, therapy, community activities, birthday and special occasion celebration, free Wi-fi, laundry and utilities*)

Participants are required to:

- Collaborate monthly with staff and existing counselors, social workers, and outside agencies
- Meet with Program Manager weekly to discuss schedules and goals
- Enroll in school or obtain full time employment within 30 days
- Adhere to house curfews (*Curfews range from 7 pm to 11 pm*)
- Share in household chores
