Overview of mental/behavioral health services: Our experienced behavioral health (BH) and social assistance teams work alongside our medical clinicians to help patients manage depression, family concerns, anxiety, trauma, risky behaviors, chronic diseases, child and adolescent well-being, ADHD, substance use and abuse, family violence, etc. Psychiatrists consult with our medical and BH clinicians to ensure our patients receive the best care through effective assessment, evaluation, diagnosis, medication management and therapeutic services. We offer counseling in English and Spanish. Interpreter services are available for other languages. Social Assistance Workers are available to help patient’s access resources, address urgent financial issues and work through housing problems, violence, sexual assault and other issues with the goal of promoting self-efficacy in all areas of life that impact health and well-being.

Cost: OneWorld accepts most forms of insurance, Medicare and Medicaid. Those without insurance, we base our charges on a sliding fee scale. We require proof of one month’s worth of income to determine the fees for services rendered.

Additional Information: OneWorld has a Teen and Young Adult Health Center (TYAHC) located at 4310 S. 24th Street, provides confidential, compassionate care for young people ages 12-24. TYAHC is available to help young adults with everything from school/sports physicals, treatment for acne, birth control prescriptions and STD testing and treatment. TYAHC’s highly qualified staff is trained in all aspects of teen and young adult physical, emotional, mental and sexual health.

OneWorld’s School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs), are located inside four Omaha Public Schools (Indian Hill Elementary, Bryan High School, Liberty Elementary, Spring Lake Elementary) and are open to all OPS students (regardless of the school they attend) and their siblings under the age of 19. Non-Emergency Medical and Behavioral Health Services are available.

*Insurance or Medicaid is welcome at each of these clinics, but coverage is not required for care. Patients who do not have insurance will be charged based on a sliding fee scale.
