 - Section 1: what LB 390 addresses

 - Section 3: model Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
 - Section 4: minimum requirements of MOU
 - MOUs need to be in place by 2021
 - Don't need to write these MOUs from scratch, there are MOUs currently in place in other states (i.e., Ohio, Massachusetts) that have parts in them that pertain to areas that need to be in place in these MOUs
 - SROs haven't had this bill presented to them yet because it's so new
